WHEREAS, MCL 211.30 provides an alternative starting date of Wednesday following the second Monday of March.

WHEREAS, the assessor's availability to assist the board of review on that day shall be the reason for selecting the Wednesday following the second Monday of March starting date in 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Whittemore approves the Board of Review meeting on the Wednesday following the second Monday of March in 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the assessor and Board of Review shall follow the above stated policy and federal guidelines in granting or denying an exemption. The Assessor and Board of Review are authorized to allow 100 percent (100%) of the poverty exemption when the claimant qualifies.
